PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

Site coordinators will monitor participants throughout the competition. Violation of contest rules may lead to disqualification of participant.

A. CONTEST HEADQUARTERS

Prior to the morning of the contest, all questions should be directed to the MS Coast Coliseum (594-3700). On the day of the contest, a headquarters table will be established in front of the MS Coast Coliseum Convention Center.

B. ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

The only requirement for entry is that participants should register at Coastline Paint & Hardware, 1026 East Pass Rd., Gulfport, or Bankston's Paint Center, 856 Division St., Biloxi prior to 5pm, Thursday, June 5, 2008. Harrison County beach barrels will be available for the contest.

C. APPROVED MATERIALS

Each barrel will be provided with one quart of base paint. Participants must provide all other tools and paint for artwork, design or scene. Base coat paint and one t-shirt per can will be provided by Bankston's Paint Center, your Benjamin Moore Dealer, or by Coastline Paint, your Pratt & Lambert dealer. Participants will choose base color when registering for the contest. Artwork paint must be exterior grade. Paint thinner will be available on day of contest. Participants may bring a stand to elevate barrel if desired. Additional

barrels cannot be used for this purpose. Can must be decorated with paint only. No airbrushing allowed. Parents will not be allowed to help youth participants.

D. JUDGING

Entries will be judged on how the artists interpret the theme "Saluting our Volunteers". Points will be awarded on originality, appearance and appropriateness. The decision of the judges is final. Judges reserve the right to disqualify artwork deemed inappropriate. County regulations prohibit painting of any commercial logos or advertisements. Painting of any entry may not begin prior to 8:00am on June 7, 2008. Painters must be finished by 1:00pm. An awards ceremony will be held at 2:00pm on the Concourse stage. Judges are independent teams.

E. CHECK-IN

Participants may start painting at 8:00am on June 7, 2008. All participants must check in at the registration table in front of the Convention Center. Check in hours: 7am-9am. Work sites will be assigned at that time. All participants must check in for final instructions. YOU MUST CLAIM YOUR CAN BY 9:00AM ON JUNE 7, 2008, OR YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR RESERVATION FOR THE CAN. PARTICIPANTS CANNOT KEEP THE BARRELS. Cans are the property of Harrison County, and will be used for waste disposal following the event.
